Comparison: Southwest unions

Is labor union membership on the decline in New Mexico? A look at the numbers for the five-state area of New Mexico, Arizona, Colorado, Texas and Utah for 2012 to 2013 reveals that New Mexico had the greatest increase in total employed and was second only to Texas in increased union membership and representation. While union membership and representation as a percent of employed decreased, New Mexico still demonstrates a healthy environment for unions when compared to neighboring states.
